Walk and Discover - The Ancient Mystery -



About the Furuichi Tumulus Cluster

More than 120 kofun, ancient tumuli, were constructed from the late 4th century to the mid 6th century. There are 45 remaining kofun. Seven of them are huge and their mound lengths exceed 200m.

Ojin-tenno-ryo Kofun



This is the second largest kofun in Japan with its mound length of 425m. This kofun uses the largest volume of soil in Japan. It seems to have been constructed in the early 5th century.

Recommended Walking Courses

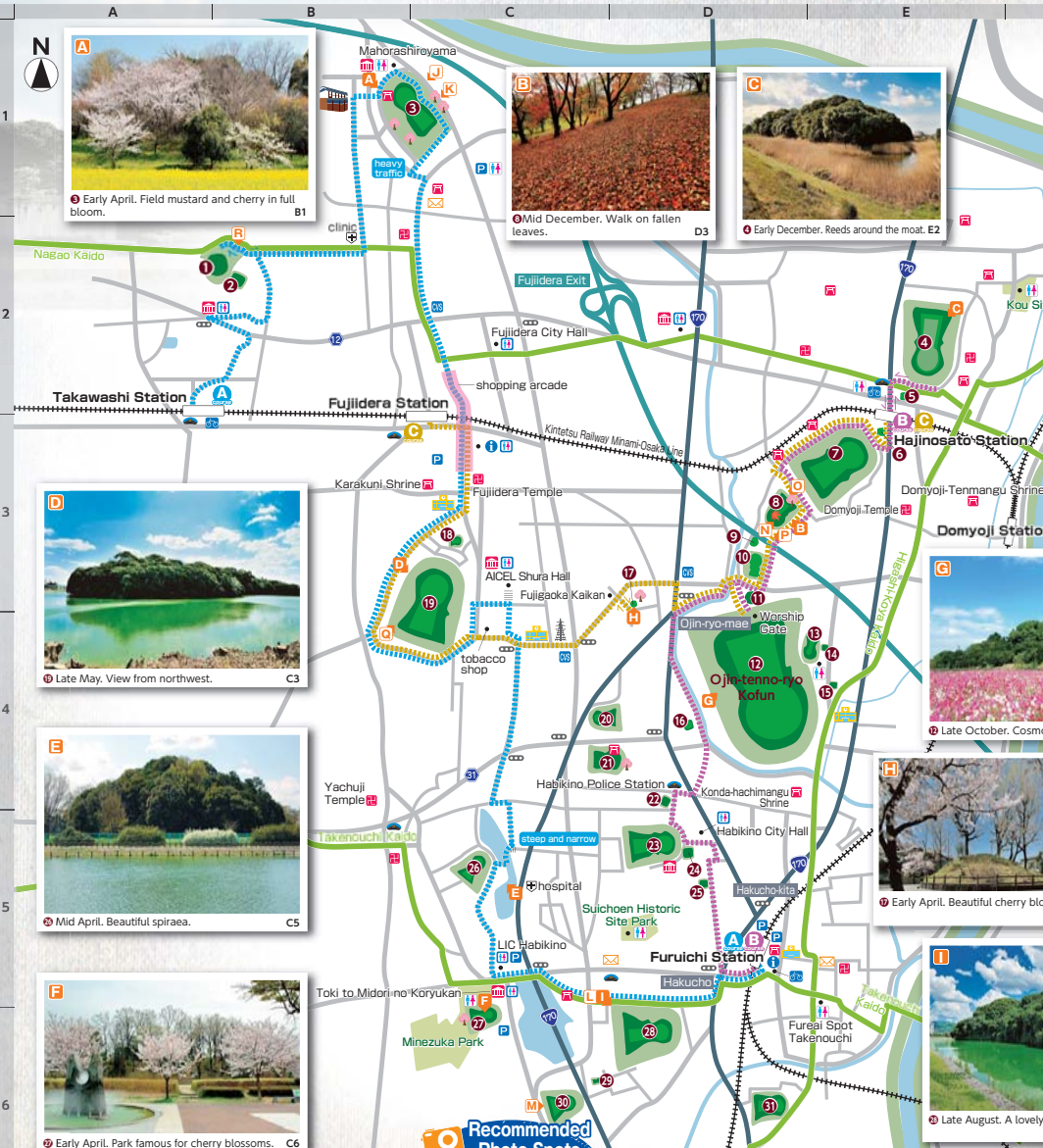
A course From Yuryaku-tenno-ryo Kofun to Yamatakerunomikoto-hakuchoryo Kofun. Long course.

B course Take the challenge and see the central sites quickly. Short course.

C course Walk around the scenic spots of the Furuichi Tumulus Cluster. Shutterbugs course.

Access to Ojin-tenno-ryo Kofun Worship Gate

- By train: approx. 60min from Shin-Osaka Sta. (Shinkansen) → Tennoji Sta. → Otsu-Abenobashi Sta. → Hajinosato Sta. (on foot)
- By car: approx. 5-minute drive to the south from "Fujiidera Exit" on the Nishi-Meihan Expressway.
- By bus: approx. 110min by way of Kawachinagano Sta. Kansai International Airport → Kawachinagano Sta. → Furuichi Sta. (Airport bus) (Ikoma Railway semi-express)
- By train: approx. 80min by way of Tennoji Sta. Kansai International Airport → Tennoji Sta. → Otsu-Abenobashi Sta. → Hajinosato Sta. (Airport bus) (Ikoma Railway semi-express)
