


- ●By Shinkansen Bullet Train Take the JR line from Shin-Osaka station, and get off at Osaka station. Change to the Kansai Airport or Kishu Rapid Express, and get off at Mikunigaoka station. Change to the local train and get off at JR Hanwa Line Mozu Station (about 50 min.). Walk west for 500m.
- **By Plane** Get on the rapid express from JR Kansai Airport Station, get off at Otori station, then change to the local train and get off at Mozu Station (about 45 min.). Walk west for 500m.
- **By Car** About 10 min. southeast by car from the "Sakai" exit off of Hanshin Expressway No.15 Sakai
- *Parking is limited, so please use public transportation if possible.



How to get to Ojin-tenno-ryo Kofun

- ●By Shinkansen Bullet Train Get on either the JR Line or the Subway Midosuji Line at Shin-Osaka station and take it to Tennoji Station. Change to the Minami Osaka Line at Kintestu Osaka Abenobashi Station, and get off at either Hajinosato Station (about 55 min.) or Furuichi Station (about 60 min.). The Ojin-tenno-ryo Kofun is about 1200m southwest from Hajinosato Station (★2) and about 700m northwest from Furuichi Station (★3).
- ■By Plane Get on the rapid express from JR Kansai Airport Station, then get off at Tennoji Station. Change to the Minami Osaka Line at Kintestu Osaka Abenobashi Station, and get off at either Hajinosato Station (about 80 min.) or Furuichi Station (about 85 min.)
- **By Car** About 5 min. southeast by car from the "Fuijidera" exit off of the Nishi-Meihan Expressway.



Mounded tombs are the burial mounds that act as tombs for ancient kings and royalty. Large tombs also serve as symbols of authority, and were made all over the world. In Japan there are the circular "round mounded tombs," the quadrilateral "square mounded tombs," and the both round and square "keyhole-shaped mounded tombs." There are many large and small mounded tombs, including the "Nintoku-tenno-ryo Kofun," one of the world's three largest burial mounds.





From Furuichi to Mozu / Indulgent Course

Once you've enjoyed the mounded tombs from the land and the air, go to the Mozu area, which has Japan's largest mounded tomb and is full of Sakai history and culture. Use the Mozu-Furuichi Kofungun Shuyu Bus (Mozu-Furuichi Mounded Tomb Group Loop Bus).


